We are a CD label specializing in progressive rock. Many of our efforts are reissues of rare albums from the 70s which have not made the transition to digital. In fact we reissued a number of classic German progressive rock albums from the 70s including three albums by Schicke Fuhrs Frohling, Yatha Sidhra, and even Faithful Breath.

We take an audiophile approach to our reissues - always trying to remain faithful to the original analog source. It is important that we have a high quality vinyl reference to compare our digital masters against. I have had a number of phono stages in our reference system over the years with little satisfaction. Recently we were relying on the phono section of our Bxxxxxx 1xxxx preamp. Confidentially I was not happy.

To that end I contacted Daniel Barnum at Half Note Audio to inquire about a Basis Exclusive. We quickly had one installed in our system and I have to say that it has been sonic nirvana! I have never heard vinyl playback sound like this. The musicality of the phono stage is extraordinary - very dynamic with tremendous bass and a purely organic natural sound. I have receive the ASR I Emitter on Friday evening and i did set up on Saturday morning. ASR has outperformed the AXXXXX AMP I in the first minute . The big difference is on mid and high octaves, these are like tube sound. It has enormous bass control and a very good sound stage .

The interesting thing is the bass control. Even it is said that AXXXX AMP I has a damping factor of 4000 at 500 Hz which looks like better than ASR, you can hear that ASR is much better . I think this is because of perfect power supply of ASR.

"Hey Guys!

I'm no writer but I just couldn't keep this to myself. I am absolutely blown away by the performance of the Concert Grand Si driven by the ASR Emitter II Exclusive. This combination represents the best I have ever heard this speaker perform. The upper frequencies are more extended, sweet and airy. Midrange continues to be natural but there was a greater sense of presence to the sound. The overall sound is more pure in a way I find difficult to describe. It simply didn't matter what type of music I played. This combination is simply a wonderful match as the speaker literally became a living breathing thing. I am truly impressed. I could only expect the same performance with the Emitter I Exclusive (\$14K) on the Bodhran SE.

Let's talk about bass. I used one of my reference tunes by the YellowJackets ( Live Wires, 1992 - Track 9 - Wildlife ). This is a live recording and I literally felt like I was in the audience. The percussion, bass and audience came to life in a manner never before experienced in my 25 x 15 x 8 foot music room. The CGSi loves the power. The sound is organic and there was a natural height to the performance. The presentation was wide and the soundstage deep with layering you could nearly walk into. With all due respect to John Mark's experience, I never agreed with his limited bass comment as the CGSi's bass was never any less than tuneful and controlled in my room when driven by the highly respected Lamm Reference Electronics. However, with the ASR driving them, the bass was even tighter and very very deep. Mr. Marks would easily retract those comments if he heard this tune on this speaker amp combination in my room.

Best of all, because the ASR Emitter II is an integrated unit, it represents a tremendous value at \$23K. It outputs 500W into 4 ohms, has 2 separate power supplies, 1 balanced and 1 direct input, 2 tape outputs and a remote control. This unit comes with two " very good" power cords (of course the unit sounds better with the Argento FLOW cords used in this system). The B version includes a battery option (\$4K up-charge)

## **A customer from Benelux about the new Emitter II Exclusive Battery from July 2007**

I had read so many positive reviews about your famous Emitter on the internet, that I decided to buy it even without previously having a listening session. I wanted to be surprised. Well, I can say I was! When I listened the first time, brandnew from the factory, I already heard differences, compared to my previous LFD bi-amping set. Due to the battery unit, the sound was smoother and I already heard more details when I played certain CD's. But this was only the beginning... To all potential buyers: please be patient with the Emitter; don't judge it straight out of the box. I know there are people who find it nonsense about burn-in time of high-end equipment, but I can assure you: this amplifier has to be burnt in before it reaches all his capacities. 200 hours is really a minimum (at least for the battery version).  
Once this is done, the sound is really different, compared to the first hours. All the reviews you read on the internet are really true! Hereafter I will give you a rather detailed overview of what I experienced with my new machine. To my Emitter are connected:

- loudspeakers Audiodata Ambiance
- CD-player Marantz SA-11S1
- interconnect LFD "grainless"
- loudspeaker cables Monitor (In-akustik) "Black and white"

In the first place there is an impressive spaciousness, in particular with classical and jazz recordings. When you play a symphony or concerto, the Emitter produces a 3-dimensional sound with a soundstage as if the orchestra were in front of you: you hear the strings in the front and then suddenly you hear the brass instruments as if they were playing behind the loudspeakers. Very breathtaking! The placement of instruments and voices is very impressive. I like very much classical music but opera was not really my cup of tea because I found it mostly too long-winded... at least until now. With this machine, when you play a live recording, you almost feel the singers move on the stage and you can easily distinguish the voices.

By the way, that's another feature of the Emmi: individual voices sound different; they sound more in a natural way and often much closer to the listener than before. It's difficult to explain in words, I believe it's the acoustics of the room where the recording took place, you hear.

Church organ, one of my favourite instruments because of the superb color palette this instrument can produce, sounds like I've never experienced it before: when it plays with all the registers open you hear an enormous wide soundstage and in the quiet passages you hear all those special sounds, which I call the "little birds".

In jazz and big band music, the most remarkable is how pure and natural the brass instruments sound. Especially when they play all together. Then you hear how powerful the Emitter is.

All this apply only to good recordings. A bad recording won't sound good on the Emitter, that's quite obvious, but it will sound better, it will sound smoother.

If you have the chance to have recordings, which I call "outstanding", then the listening with the Emitter is really unbelievable. I have some CD's which play really with complete absence of coloration or electronics whatever. The artists are really performing in front of you; you have the feeling of a live concert! On a particular CD, where a

saxophonist is playing, you hear not only the breathing of the performer but also the air that's coming out of his saxophone! Unfortunately, such CD's are rare, too rare...

The Emitter II Exclusive version 2007 is a very outstanding amplifier with a sound I've never heard before:

1. it has an amazing 3-dimensional soundstage
2. it has a very beautiful, smooth and natural sound. Especially drums, percussion, cello and wind instruments sound very natural.
3. good recordings make this set produce so many details, you ask yourself "how is it possible all this kept hidden before?"

This amplifier forces you to listen to the music because it produces music in the way it should be. Whether you play a recording with 1 instrument or a complete orchestra with 80 instruments, all is played with the most ease and without distortions.

Beside all these positive comments, aren't there any negative? In my opinion only 2, which aren't in fact negative:

1. you need a lot of room to stock the set but this is rather easy to solve: I've made a (very solid) rack in which I put the battery and the 2 power supplies. In this way the Emitter and the rack take only the room of a regular pre-amplifier and a power amplifier.
2. with this set you want to do only 3 things: listen, listen and listen. Even when you've been listening for hours, you want more... So, this amplifier might make you forget about all the rest...

Mr. Schaefer, you've done a very great job. All my congratulations to you! Congratulations too for the award "best value for money" you won at the Munich High End Show 2007. I can only totally agree: I believe your Emitter is the best you can get at this price.

Even after four years of living with Emitters every day; they still manage to surprise me which is an impressive feat!

I think this is particularly apparent in the combination of Emitter and Westminsters though as the Tannoys are extremely dynamic and responsive themselves and really need an amplifier like the Emitters to show their full potential.

I am sure you have received many similar mails written by more talented writers than me, but I must congratulate you by your excellent amplifier. My current system is Audio ( Tube CD from USA ) CD7 , the ASR Emitter II excl. and Krell speakers connected with XXXXXXXXX Reference cables - I must tell you I got a bargain on these fantastic speakers second hand, otherwise they would not be in my budget.

The ASR have been playing continuously now for 150 hours, and shares little resemblance with the first days sound. Inner detail and musicality of this system of music are easily the best I ever had in my listening room, coupled with a sensation of physical presence and power.

By the way I tried using my ( Tube preamp from USA ) as a preamplifier using the ASR at level "51" but it degraded the quality of the system - it only augmented my consideration for the preamplifier part of the ASR.

The most interesting thing is that I got my Krell because the previous owner could not tame their excessive bass response in his room. I was also having great problems in the 30-60 Hz octave, but the bass with ASR is now perfectly controlled.

I can now listen both to my Shostakovich 11th Symphony and Brahms Sextets with great pleasure!

## **From the Tannoy Forum in december 2003 about an Emitter II HD (german model) 2003 model**

Maybe you remember some weeks ago I offered my pair of Westminster speakers for sale. Some of you were interested, but nobody was willing to pay the shipping cost for these monsters to beam them from Germany to the US. Most of you said 'Are you crazy? Why are you going to sell these wonderfull speakers?'. Well, I have to thank you for that. I've changed my mind and will keep them for myself. Anyone interested in reading why? But be warned, I will also be talking about that banned amp made by the small factory in Germany ;-)

This is going to be a rather long story but believe me the Westminster is worth it.

I purchased the speakers about 18 months ago and tried them a while with my Mark Levinson ML-26 pre-amp and ML-23 power amps. This was my first experience with a Tannoy speaker and I was not satisfied with the sound. The bass was rather poor, not as powerful as I had expected. The biggest problem was that the Westminster sounded colored in the mid range. I didn't understand why such a legendary speaker could sound so bad. The Mark Levinson amps - especially my rather old models - are well known worldwide for their high-end performance and they sound just perfect when driving my Bowers & Wilkens 801 Series 2 speakers. I must say that I'm an audio enthusiast for almost 30 years and the ML / B&W combo satisfied my needs just perfectly for about eight years now. It was a long way until I arrived at what seemed to be the high-end. You can see parts of my system on Hans' web site.

Some months ago I offered my Westminsters on German eBay. This was when I came across Werner. He contacted me and gave me a lot of information on Tannoy speakers and he told me about this group. I cancelled my eBay auction since I got no bids anyway. I signed up here and read your emails since then. I learned that most of you drive your Tannoys with tube amps and Werner recommended that banned amp. OK, I decided to give my Westminsters one more try. Of course you can't find a Westminster in an audio shop here in Germany and of course you also can't talk high-end audio dealers into bringing their monster amps to your home for testing. So I tried with what I had at home and also spent some money for new equipment. Now I can say that I had them all. I tested with the ML amps, with other transistor amps, with a tube amp and with the banned amp.

From my home cinema setup I have a new Denon AVR-3803 AV-receiver. I tried it with the Westminster with my SONY CDP-X7 ESD CD player and Parasound D/AC-1500. I was somewhat surprised that the sound was significantly better compared to the ML amps. How could this be? The Denon costs about 1000,-- Euro while the ML amps cost about 20.000,-- Euro when new, well 40.000,-- DM at that time ;-)

The next step was to connect my good old Sansui AU-9500. This was their high-end amp in 1972. You can see it on the [www.retroaudio.ru](http://www.retroaudio.ru) web site. The Sansui amps are said to sound much like tube amps and I read here that tubes are a must for the Tannoys. I also setup a turntable instead of CD, a Thorens TD 2001 with an Audio-Technica OC-9. I had to use the ML-25 phono pre-amp to connect it to the Sansui which is lacking an MC input. Wow, that was a big step in the right direction! I tried quite a few records and convinced my wife that the Westminsters was indeed worth a deeper look.

OK, the next step was to purchase a real tube amp. I wasn't sure if I should try a high-end tube amp right away or better try with a low cost product first. I didn't want to spend too much money just for testing and found a used Cayin 734 in like new condition on German eBay. Cayin is the brand name in Germany, I think they are sold under the Spark label in the rest of the world. I could hardly await its

arrival and connected it immediately replacing the Sansui but keeping the turntable. Oh boy, this rather simple amp made me quite happy already. Anyone here said that a Westminster is colored? You are wrong!! This was the day I decided to keep the Westminster.

So what should I do next? I read much here about a certain amp made in Germany that is the perfect companion for my speakers. Werner's comments were always so enthusiastic and I had no reason why I should not follow his recommendation and give it a try. But how could I do? Even in Germany it isn't easy to get hold of such an amp. For a new one you have to wait for months. I found a few used amps offered at [www.audio-markt.de](http://www.audio-markt.de). One seemed to be very interesting so I contacted the owner for more information including the serial number. Werner always said call Friedrich Schaefer if you want information on one of his babies. I did. I couldn't believe but I got Mr. Schaefer on the phone without problems. I told him what I was looking for and first thing he did was not trying to sell me a new amp but pointed me to exactly the used amp I already had in mind. He seems to be aware of all his products being sold online or through one of his dealers. Mr. Schaefer is a very nice person, open to discuss every aspect of his products and very helpful, exactly like Werner had promised. Have you talked to the developer of your favorite amp lately ;-) To make things short, about three days later I had my ASR Emitter II HD Akku at home. This is the top model ASR offers. It is about three years old but looks like new and is technically identical to the current models since it was updated early this year by ASR.

The manual says I should power up the amp and wait for three days until it is warmed up. Would you be patient enough to wait so long before you try your new amp? I'm not. A friend of mine who is also experienced with high-end audio for many years helped me setting the system up. All in all this amp weighs about 130 kg so help is very much welcome. We listened to a few CDs we both know well and compared the Westminster / ASR combo with the B&W / ML setup I loved so much. Even with the ASR not having warmed up it became clear very quickly that this combination was very much better than my old set. In every aspect I guess.

I left everything as it was and waited one day. The good sound has become even better as anyone would have expected. On the third day the system sounded just perfect. It is difficult for me to describe sound or feelings in words since English isn't my mother tongue. Let me just say that never before in my life I have heard a high-end system coming as close to the real thing as this one. Does anyone know the CD Duets by Rob Wasserman? It was issued in 1988. Mr. Wasserman plays bass and other artists join him for duets. There is a track with Lou Reed 'One for my baby and one more for the road'. Set the Emitter to a volume level of about 52-55 and close your eyes. At the end of the track you wanna make shake hands with Lou Reed. You are sure he was there in person. Incredible!

What I learned is that the Westminster is very sensitive regarding the amp used with it. I've never heard another speaker that sounds so much different with different amps. It is also very important to position the speakers properly in the listening room. With my current setup I can say that the Westminster sounds as close as it can get to a life performance. The best I've ever heard. In every aspect. Period. I will keep my Westminster and the ASR Emitter and fine tune the system in the future.

I have to thank Werner for convincing me to keep the Westminster and giving them another try with the ASR Emitter. I never met Werner in person. I only know him by email and talked once to him on the phone. Werner has lots of experience and much useful information. I think it is a pity that he has left the group. Werner was right with everything he told us about his system. This Westminster / ASR Emitter combo is certainly one of those rare perfect sets everyone of

us is searching for.

Did I say that I tested with low cost equipment until now? Well, I wanted to compare this with my old system and left that one unchanged. All the above was done with using simple speaker cables and just a 100,-- Euro CD player with the ASR!! Today I hooked up my turntable and listened to one of my favorite Dires Straits albums - Brother in Arms. Then followed Red Red Wine by UB40. It was so realistic. I had goose bumps all over my body like I haven't had before for a very long time....

I'm sure there are some options to still improve my new system. I'm open for your advice. I guess I should at least replace the capacitors in the crossovers. Does anyone have a circuit diagram of the crossover? Are there any capacitors used that should be changed after 20 years? I know that some types are dry and change their capacitance after so many year. What is behind that front plate with the switches? Are there resistor networks for setting the tweeter level? I've set the switches to the flat position so I think it would be a good idea to eliminate them completely to avoid unneeded connectors and the like in the signal path. My rather old Westminster does not yet have bi-wiring terminals. Do you think it is worth converting them to bi-wiring?
